Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to remind you of the need for all pupils to wear the correct school uniform.

Recently, we have had many of our female students wearing elasticated trousers, sometimes known as “jeggings”. These are not part of the school’s uniform, nor have they ever been. Unfortunately, the community has not been helped by the fact that some retailers have been selling these as school trousers, but I must inform you that they are not.

Realising that you have already spent money on trousers you thought were appropriate, the academy is prepared to contribute a significant sum towards the cost of replacement trousers, meaning that a new pair will cost just £8 rather than the full £19.99. A maximum of two pairs per child are able to be bought through us at this discounted rate. **We will only be able to leave this offer open until 2:30pm on Monday the 17th of October** to enable us to process this with the supplier in time to start immediately after half term. To secure your garments, your child must bring their requirements into school by Friday at the latest, with a cheque or cash for the correct amount.

If you would rather obtain alternative trousers from elsewhere then you are welcome to do so, although I would request that you please ensure that they do not have an elasticated fit and do have plenty of room in them.

If you would like to go directly to our school uniform suppliers, they can be found on the school’s website and these sell authorised uniform that is in line with the school’s requirements.

Skirts and thick black tights are still fine, as are un-elasticated trousers that are quite loose.

Continued wearing of elasticated trousers after half term will result in the consequences system being followed.
