

## De Lacy Academy Catch Up Funding 2016/17

### BACKGROUND

The Year 7 catch up premium is additional funding for pupils who have left primary school without achieving the expected level in either literacy or Mathematics. This funding is to enable schools to provide catch up and intervention strategies to accelerate progress and ensure that these pupils reach their expected levels for their age group in English and Maths.

Total amount of Catch up funding received	£16,000
In Year 7 there are 14 students in receipt of either catch up literacy or numeracy funding and 6 students who are in receipt of both.
